Repentance 2 Deliverance Redemption Reunification

Repentance

Definition: A turning away from sin and turning toward God.

"Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand."

— Matthew 4:17

Why: Without repentance, there is no forgiveness. It's the first step toward salvation and transformation.

"Unless you repent, you will all likewise perish."

— Luke 13:3

False Teachings (Christ Consciousness/New Age):

New Age beliefs typically reject the need for repentance, emphasizing that humanity is inherently divine and doesn't need to turn away from sin. Christ Consciousness teaches that we only need to awaken to our own divinity, without acknowledging sin.

2 Deliverance

Definition: God's power to free us from spiritual bondage and oppression.

"He has sent me to proclaim freedom for the prisoners... to set the oppressed free." — Luke 4:18

Why: We cannot serve God while still bound. Deliverance brings freedom to walk in our calling and obey God fully.

"Whom the Son sets free is free indeed." - John 8:36

False Teachings (Christ Consciousness/New Age):

In Christ Consciousness/New Age, the concept of deliverance is often replaced with self-empowerment or "inner freedom" through awakening. There's a focus on spiritual practices or "raising consciousness" rather than true freedom in Christ.

Redemption

Definition: Jesus purchasing our freedom through His sacrifice.

"In Him we have redemption through His blood..."

— Ephesians 1:7

Why: Without redemption, we remain under the penalty of sin.
Only His blood can pay the price for our salvation.

"Without the shedding of blood, there is no forgiveness of sins."

— Hebrews 9:22

False Teachings (Christ Consciousness/New Age):

New Age teachings reject the necessity of Jesus' sacrifice, suggesting that all paths lead to God and that there is no need for blood atonement. Christ Consciousness teaches that we are all "Saviors" in our own right and don't need redemption.



Definition: Restored relationship with God and realignment of His plan for us through Christ.

"God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself..."

— 2 Corinthians 5:19

Why: We were created for union with God. True salvation restores that relationship—now and for eternity.

"I am the way... No one comes to the Father except through Me."

— John 14:6

False Teachings (Christ Consciousness/New Age):

Christ Consciousness/New Age teach that we can achieve unity with the divine through personal enlightenment or meditation, healing and downplaying the necessity of Jesus as the only way to the Father. The emphasis is on universalism rather than the exclusive truth of Christ.
